



## Operation Transformation: Discover Purpose

### CONNECT

- What is the best thing you have ever made? Could be food, clothes, etc.

### WORD

#### **Acts 13:36**

*"Now when David had served God's purpose in his own generation, he fell asleep; he was buried with his ancestors and his body decayed."*

### THOUGHT

As God's creation (Psalm 139:14) sometimes we start off thinking we are made for one thing, we have one purpose. But, when we encounter God He shows us our true purpose, for what and why we were created... Jeremiah 29:11. David started off as a shepherd, but he was born to be a king! David's purpose was more than just being the best shepherd, but to ultimately be the man, the king after God's own heart. (1 Samuel 16:13)

### DISCUSSION

**1. Have you ever worked in a specific field in a company, but felt that you were called to be in another? How did you handle this situation?**

**2. Have you ever been overlooked for a job opportunity that you really wanted? How did you respond?**

**3. Do you believe that God is sovereign and has your destiny in his hands? (Psalm 37:23)**

**4. Jesus, unlike most of us came to earth knowing exactly what His sole purpose. Do you know why God has put you on earth, in this time? What purpose does He have for you to live out?**

**5. In discovering (or discovered) your purpose for why God put you here, have you helped others know God, grow together and discover their purposes?**

### **PERSONAL APPLICATION**

- This week spend time thinking and writing down the ways God has shown you, your purpose.
- This week help someone else discover his or her purpose, then share together what you find.

### **PRAYER**

- Pray over the desires and plans in your heart and life, asking God to align them with His will and purpose for you life. Scripture shares with us that we that in the mind, a man plans his ways, but the Lord directs His path. (Proverbs 16:9)
- Pray with a friend over your lives that your purpose would be found in Christ. Also praying that you would better Know God, and Grow Together with the people around you.
