Genesis 5:22-24

"After he begot Methuselah, Enoch walked with God three hundred years, and had sons and daughters. So all the days of Enoch were three hundred and sixty-five years. And Enoch walked with God; and he was not, for God took him."

THOUGHT

God is looking for not only a clinging bride but also a walking partner. From the very beginning, God had a relationship with Adam and Eve that found them "walking in the garden in the cool of the day" (Genesis 3:8). God created man for the enjoyment of a walking relationship that involved companionship, dialogue, intimacy, joint decision-making, mutual delight, and shared dominion. God longs to walk with you, which is why his arms of grace have been pulling you into a closer walk with him. The secret place is not the destination; it is only the catalyst. It is designed of God to establish us in an intimate friendship with him that is walked out through the course of our everyday lives. The goal we're after is an everyday walk of unbroken communion with our Lord and friend. Enoch was the first man in the Bible who walked with God.

| 4. What are some significant moments in your life that you can remember while walking with God? Can you name one of these moments? |
| 5. Enoch walked faithfully with the Lord and then he was no more. Has there been a moment in your life in which you prayed asking God to help you in a situation and He did? What happened? |
